

D.P. 13570, Block IV, Maungatautari Survey District, to the south-eastern corner of the said Section 3 of D.P. 13570; thence continuing in the south-easterly direction across the Te Awamutu - Cambridge Main Highway to the western boundary of Section P.T. 10 of D.P. 3938, Block IV, Maungatautari Survey District; thence in, firstly, a southerly and then easterly direction along the western and southern boundaries of Section P.T. 10 of D.P. 3938, Block IV, Maungatautari Survey District, to the south-eastern corner of the said Section P.T. 10 of D.P. 3938; thence in a straight line across country in a south-easterly direction to the point where the Puahue-Rotorangi Road crosses the Mangapiko Stream; thence in a straight line across country in an easterly direction to Trig. 1299, located in the north-eastern portion of Block V, Mangatautari Survey District; thence continuing in a straight line across country in an easterly direction to the Maungatautari Trig. No. 1427, located on the eastern boundary of the Waipa County in the western portion of Block VII, Maungatautari Survey District; thence following the said county boundary in a southerly direction to the Waikato River; thence following the Waikato River upstream to the point where the said river and the boundaries of the Matamata, Otorohanga, and Taupo Counties meet. From this point in a straight line across country in a westerly direction to Trig. 1548, located in the south-western portion of Block XVI, Wharepapa Survey District; thence in a straight line across country in a south-westerly direction to the south-western corner of Section P.T. 1, Block III, Ranginui Survey District; thence in a westerly direction along the southern boundaries of Sections 2, 3, 4, and 5, Block III, Ranginui Survey District, to the western boundary of the said Block III; thence following the western boundary of the said Block III to the south-eastern corner of Section 11, Block II, Ranginui Survey District; thence in a westerly direction along the southern boundaries of Sections 11, 10, and 5A, Block II, Ranginui Survey District, to the western boundary of the said Block II; thence in a northerly direction along the western boundaries of Blocks II, XIV, and X, Ranginui and Wharepapa Survey Districts, to the south-western corner of Section 3, Block X, Wharepapa Survey District; thence in a westerly direction along the southern boundaries of Sections 3, 2, and 6, Block IX, Wharepapa Survey District, to the Mangatutu River; thence following the said river downstream to the point where it is bridged by the Wharepunga Main Highway in the north-western corner of Block V, Wharepapa Survey District; thence following along the said highway in a generally westerly direction to the point where it crosses the Main Trunk Railway in the Township of Te Kawa; thence following the said railway in a southerly direction to the northern boundary-line of Block XIII, Puniu Survey District; thence in a westerly direction along the northern boundaries of Blocks XIII and XVI, Puniu and Pirongia Survey Districts, to the Waipa River; thence following the Waipa River downstream to the point where it meets the southern boundary of the Waipa County; thence in a straight line across country in a westerly direction to the point where the Moakurua Stream intersects the southern boundary of Section P.T. 2b, Block XII, Pirongia Survey District; thence following the said stream upstream to the point where it is bridged by the Kawhia-Kawa Main Highway; thence in a straight line across country in a westerly direction to Trig. Hikurangi, located in the northern portion of Block XIV, Pirongia Survey District; thence in a straight line across country in a south-westerly direction to the point where the boundaries of the Kawhia, Otorohanga, and Waitomo Counties meet; thence in a straight line across country in a westerly direction to Trig. V, located in the eastern portion of Block III, Kawhia South Survey District; thence in a straight line across country in a south-westerly direction to Trig. Pukerangiora, located in the eastern portion of Block II, Kawhia Survey District; thence in a straight line across country in a westerly direction to Trig. Z, located on the eastern boundary of Section 7 in the south-western portion of Block II, Kawhia South Survey District; thence in a generally northerly direction along the eastern boundaries of Sections 7, 6, 5, and 4, Block II, Kawhia Survey District, to meet the western bank of the Waiharakeke Stream; thence following the western bank of the said stream downstream to the Kawhia Harbour; thence following the southern shore of the said harbour to the sea-coast; thence following along the sea-coast in a northerly direction to the entrance of Aotea Harbour; thence following the southern shore-line of the said harbour in a generally easterly direction to the point where the boundaries of the Raglan and Kawhia Counties meet; being in the south-western portion of Block XIV, Karioi Survey District, being the original point of commencement.
