

## Price Order No. 948 (Amendment No. 1 of Price Order No. 904) (Chocolates)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act, 1947, the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following amending Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 948, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 904\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
2. This Order shall come into force on the 8th day of November, 1948.
3. The principal Order is hereby amended by inserting in the Schedule thereto under the appropriate headings the kind of chocolate and the prices set out in the Schedule hereto.

## Price Order No. 946 (Amendment No. 1 of Price Order No. 920) (Wholesale Groceries and Other Goods)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act, 1947, the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following amending Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 946, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 920\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
2. This Order shall come into force on the 8th day of November, 1948.
3. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—
  - (a) By omitting the words "Other than salmon" where they appear under the heading "Fish, canned—", and substituting the words "All other canned fish and canned-fish pie".
  - (b) By omitting all the items in paragraph (a) appearing under the heading "Foods".
  - (c) By omitting the references to "Molasses", and substituting the references set out hereunder:—
