IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by section sixty-one of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby direct that from the moneys received in respect of the Rimu Domain, described in the First Schedule hereto, and at the date hereof lying to the credit of the said domain, a sum not exceeding twenty-five pounds shall be applied in managing, administering, and improving the Woodstock Domain described in the Second Schedule hereto.

BY virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by the thirty-fourth section of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby order and declare that the reserve for recreation in the Canterbury Land District described in the Schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby brought under the operation of and declared to be subject to the provisions of Part II of the said Act; and such reserve shall hereafter be known as the Omihiri Domain, and be managed, administered, and dealt with as a public domain.

PURSUANT to section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Wanganui City Council on the twenty-first day of September, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, in so far as it affects the side and portion of street described in the Schedule hereto, viz.:

"The Wanganui City Council, being the local authority having the control of streets in the City of Wanganui, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that portion of street known as Pehi Street adjoining Lot 19 on Deeds Plan 117; a distance of 158.5 links";

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the south-western side of the portion of Pehi Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.
