Exemption Order Under the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940

Now, therefore, the Minister of Lands, acting in pursuance of section 27 of the said Act, doth hereby declare that the land described in the said Schedule is taken for the settlement of discharged service-men, and hereby specifies the 28th day of February, 1949, as the date on which the said land shall be deemed to be vested in His Majesty the King.
