A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the middle-line of a railway in Blocks XIV and XV, Akatarawa Survey District—viz., a portion of the Wellington-Napier via Woodville Railway (portion of Rimutaka Tunnel Deviation)—shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto.

COMMENCING at a point in Section 223, Hutt District, marked 3 miles on the plan hereinafter referred to, and proceeding thence in an easterly direction generally for a distance of approximately 1 mile 32 decimal 86 chains, and passing in, into, through, or over the following lands, &c., viz., Sections 223, 136, 141, 298, and 299, Hutt District, and Railway Reserve, Block XIV, Akatarawa Survey District, State Forest Reserve, Block XV, Akatarawa Survey District, and terminating at a point marked 4 miles 32 decimal 86 chains, on the plan hereinafter referred to, including all adjoining and intervening places, lands, reserves, roads, tracks, lakes, rivers, streams, and watercourses: all in the Wellington Land District. A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the Scenery Preservation Board, constituted pursuant to the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), has recommended that the land described in the Schedule hereto should be permanently reserved for scenic purposes, and it is expedient to give effect to such recommendation:

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto shall be a scenic reserve under the said Act, and subject to the provisions thereof.
