IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in him by section three of the Main Highways Act, 1922, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby declare that on and after the second day of October, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, the main highway described in the First Schedule hereto shall cease to be a main highway within the meaning and for the purposes of the Main Highways Act, 1922.
