

The Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943.—Notice Declaring Land Taken for the Settlement of Discharged Servicemen

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 24 of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943, notice was given of the intention of the Minister of Lands to take under Part II of the said Act the land described in the Schedule hereto, and a copy of the said notice was published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 1 on the 13th day of January, 1949, at page 10:

And whereas no objection was made in the manner prescribed by the said Act objecting to the taking of the said land:

And whereas the Land Valuation Committee did on the 3rd day of March, 1949, make an order determining that the said land is farm land suitable or adaptable for the settlement of a discharged serviceman:

And whereas no appeal from the said order was made within the time prescribed by the said Act or within any further time allowed by the Court:

And whereas the said land is not the land of any serviceman who is for the time being serving outside New Zealand in any of His Majesty's Forces or in any British ship:

Now, therefore, the Minister of Lands, acting in pursuance of section 27 of the said Act, doth hereby declare that the land described in the said Schedule is taken for the settlement of discharged servicemen, and hereby specifies the 30th day of March, 1949, as the date on which the said land shall be deemed to be vested in His Majesty the King.

SCHEDULE

OTAGO LAND DISTRICT

ALL that area containing one thousand four hundred and thirty-four (1,434) acres one (1) rood and thirty-five (35) perches, more or less, being Allotment 5, D.P. 1864, and being parts of Sections 1, 3, 4, and 5, Block II, and part of Section 1, Block VI, Bengier Survey District, and being all the land contained in certificate of title, Vol. 152, folio 211 (Otago Registry).
