*Proclaiming Maori Land to Have Become Crown Land*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section four hundred and fifty-four of the Maori Land Act, 1931, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, being satisfied that the purchase of the Maori land described in the Schedule hereto has been duly completed by or on behalf of the Crown under the authority of the said Act, do hereby proclaim that the said land has become Crown land.

SCHEDULE

ALL that piece of land situated in Block II, Wainuioru Survey District, containing 28 acres 1 rood 3 perches, more or less, being part of the land called or known as Te Wera-a-Whaitiri No. 2c 1, and being the whole of the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title, Volume 451, folio 129 (Wellington Registry).

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Land Act, 1924, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby amend the Proclamation dated the twelfth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 54 of the fourteenth day of the same month at page 1272, proclaiming land as road and road closed in Blocks XLII, XLIII, and XLVI, Tokomairiro Survey District, Bruce County, by deleting from the First Schedule to the said Proclamation the area described in the First Schedule hereto and substituting in lieu thereof the area described in the Second Schedule hereto.
