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## BANKS PENINSULA ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Redemption Loan 1949, £690

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Banks Peninsula Electric-power Board, a corporate body duly incorporated under the Electric-power Boards Act, 1925, hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on the Board's Redemption Loan, 1949, £690, authorized to be raised by Order in Council appearing in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 13, 3rd March, 1949, at page 672, the Banks Peninsula Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one one-hundred-and-fiftieth of a penny (1/150d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Banks Peninsula Electric-power District comprising the Borough of Akaroa, the Counties of Akaroa, Wairewa, Mount Herbert, and the Diamond Harbour settlement in the Borough of Lyttelton; and that such rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years or until the loan is fully paid off.”

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Reticulation Extension Loan (No. 5), 1949, £55,000

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Bay of Islands Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £55,000 (fifty-five thousand pounds), authorized to be raised by the Bay of Islands Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of providing additional moneys for the further reticulation of the Bay of Islands Electric-power District, the said Bay of Islands Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of 5/10d. (five-tenths of one penny) in the pound upon the unimproved value of all rateable property within the Bay of Islands Electric-power District; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
