1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 998, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of May, 1949.

3. The principal Order is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (i) of subclause (4) of clause 5 the words "or cordial" and the words "of cordial".
