Revoking Appointment of Trustees for Ealing Cemetery

WHEREAS by a certain Warrant of the sixteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, published in the Gazette on the twenty-eighth day of June of the same year at page 2124, His Excellency the Governor-General pursuant to section fifty-five of the Cemeteries Act, 1908 (*inter alia*), appointed the Coldstream Road Board to be trustees to provide for the maintenance and care of the Ealing Public Cemetery:
