And whereas the said committee, not being satisfied that the Crown had decided not to acquire or arrange for the acquisition of the land, did, on the 10th day of May, 1949, make an order determining the basic value of the land, and no appeal from the said order was made within the time prescribed by the said Act or within any further time allowed by the Court:
