Proclaiming Maori Land to Have Become Crown Land

PURSUANT to section four hundred and fifty-four of the Maori Land Act, 1931, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, being satisfied that the purchase of the Maori land described in the Schedule hereto has been duly completed by or on behalf of the Crown under the authority of the said Act, do hereby proclaim that the said land has become Crown land.

SCHEDULE

ALL that parcel of land containing by admeasurement 102 acres 2 roods, more or less, called or known as Waituhi-Kuratau 4B 2A 1 Block, situate in Block III, Maungaku Survey District, County of Taumarunui, as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor, Auckland, under No. M.L. 16692 (red), and thereon edged red.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the Seal of that Dominion, this 9th day of June, 1949.

ALL that land in the Wellington Land District, Taumarunui County, comprising an area of 6,055 acres 2 roods, more or less, situated in Blocks V and VI, Waimanu Survey District, Blocks III and IV, Tongariro Survey District, Blocks VIII and IX, Puketi Survey District, and Blocks I and II, Pihanga Survey District, called or known as Waimanu 2g, Section 3.
