

Hauraki Plains Drainage Area.—Notice of Intention to Make and Levy Rates

NOTICE is hereby given that it is intended, pursuant to the Hauraki Plains Act, 1926, to make and levy, on the unimproved value of all land within the district constituted under the said Act, the general rates to meet maintenance costs for the period 1st April, 1949, to 31st March, 1950, as described in the Schedule hereto.

The amount of such rates will be payable in one sum on the 19th July, 1949.

CLASS A.—On the unimproved value of all lands classified as Class A by the appraiser appointed under the said Act, sevenpence and fifty-seven one-hundredths of a penny (7-57d.) in the pound.

CLASS B.—On the unimproved value of all lands so classified as Class B, fourpence and thirty-three one-hundredths of a penny (4-33d.) in the pound.

CLASS C.—On the unimproved value of all lands so classified as Class C, one penny and eight one-hundredths of a penny (1-08d.) in the pound.
