NEW ZEALAND FORMULARY, PART 2

The references in this part of the New Zealand Formulary to the First Schedule to the Rules of Prescription Pricing shall, where applicable, be deemed to be to the Prescription Pricing Supplement 1949/1, issued by the Pharmacy Plan Industrial Committee. This amendment shall take effect with respect to all medical prescriptions and midwifery orders (whatever the date thereof) that are presented to a contractor for fulfilment on or after 1st February, 1949.

The Hamilton Milk Delivery Notice 1946, Amendment No. 13

1. This notice may be cited as the Hamilton Milk Delivery Notice 1946, Amendment No. 13, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hamilton Milk Delivery Notice 1946† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. Clause (7) of the principal notice is hereby amended as follows :—

- By revoking the words "Gamble and Laing, Von Tempsky Street, Hamilton," in relation to Zone No. 11, and substituting the words "N. A. Laing, 23 Bond Street, Claudelands."
- By revoking the words "Francis Rossiter, 8 Hukunui Road, Hamilton," in relation to Zone No. 23, and substituting the words "F. S. Kendrick, Killarney Road, Frankton."
