No. 3 Conversion Loan, 1949, of £115,000

N pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by Part II of the Local Authorities Interest Reduction and Loans Conversion Act, 1932–33, and section 20 of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1935, and the Mount Albert Borough Council Loan Conversion Order 1948, the Mount Albert Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the half-yearly instalments of principal and interest in respect of new securities authorized to be issued by the Mount Albert Borough Council under the above-mentioned Acts, the said Mount Albert Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal two five five of a penny (0.255d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of capital value) of all rateable proporty in the Borough of Mount capital value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Mount Albert; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such securities and shall be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year until the last maturity date of such securities, being the 1st day of February, 1967, and 1988, and 1989, 1967, or until all such securities are fully paid off.'
