HEREAS, at the request of certain ratepayers in the County of Tauranga, the Local Government Commission, in pursuance of the provisions of the Local Government Commission Act, 1946, resolved to hold a public inquiry into proposals for an alteration of the boundaries of the Borough of Tauranga and the County of Tauranga:

And whereas, in pursuance of the provisions of the said Act, the Local Government Commission has approved as final a scheme bearing date the seventeenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, providing for the exclusion of the areas described in the Schedule to the said scheme from the County of Tauranga and for the inclusion of such areas in the Borough of Tauranga: And whereas it is deemed expedient to give effect to the final

scheme as hereinafter appearing:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in him by the Local Government Commission Act, 1946, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare that as on and from the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, the areas described in the Schedule hereto shall be excluded from the County of Tauranga and included in the Borough of Tauranga, and, with the like advice and consent, doth hereby declare that the alteration of boundaries of the said county and the said borough hereinbefore made shall be deemed to have been effected under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933.
