WHEREAS by section forty-one of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), it is provided that the Governor-General may from time to time by Order in Council, but subject to compliance with the requirements of subsection two of section seven of the said Act, declare that the land comprised in a public domain or part thereof shall cease to be subject to Part II of the said Act; and, further, may declare either that such land shall be a public reserve for the purposes of Part I of the said Act, or Crown land available for disposal by way of sale for eash under the Land Act. available for disposal by way of sale for each under the Land Act, 1948:

And whereas the lands described in the Schedule hereto are parts of the Paraparaumu Beach Domain but are not required for domain purposes, and it is expedient to revoke the reservation over

the said lands:

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby give notice pursuant to subsection two of section seven of the said Act that it is my intention to issue an Order in Council under the provisions of section forty-one of the said Act declaring that the parts of the Paraparaumu Beach Domain described in the Schedule hereto shall cease to be subject to Part II of the said Act, and shall be deemed to be Crown lands available for disposal by way of sale for cash under the Land Act, 1948.
