

Crown Land Set Apart as a Permanent State Forest

A PROCLAMATION

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section eighteen of the Forests Act, 1921-22, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby set apart the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto as a permanent State forest.

SCHEDULE

WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICT.—WELLINGTON CONSERVANCY

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District, Waimarino County, containing by admeasurement 13 acres 1 rood 10 perches, more or less, and being Sections 4 and 5, Block VI, Karioi Survey District. As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 71/28, deposited in the Head Office of the State Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.
