HEREAS the Taradale Town Board (hereinafter called the HEREAS the Taradale Town Board (hereinafter called the said local authority) proposes, pursuant to the provisions of section three of the Main Highways Amendment Act, 1928, to borrow the sum of two hundred and ninety pounds (£290) by a loan to be known as "Main Highways Loan, 1949" (hereinafter called the said loan), for the purpose of providing the Council's share of the cost of replacing Saltwater Creek Culvert on the Napier-Hastings, via Fernhill, Main Highway:

(1) The term for which the said loan or any part thereof may be raised shall be three (3) years.

(2) The rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said loan or any part thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender a rate exceeding three pounds ten shillings (£3 10s.) per centum

(3) The said loan or any part thereof, together with interest thereon, shall be repaid by equal aggregate annual instalments extending over the term as determined in (1) above.

(4) No moneys shall be borrowed under this consent after the

expiration of two years from the date hereof.
