PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act, 1947, the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following Price

- 1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 1040.
- 2. This Order shall come into force on the 28th day of July, 1949.
- 3. (1) This Order applies with respect to any goods of the kind specified in the Schedule hereto that have been or may hereafter be imported into New Zealand and in respect of which a Price Order or an approval under section 16 of the Control of Prices Act, 1947, authorizing a wholesale selling-price is for the time being in force.
- (2) Where the importer of any goods to which this Order applies has paid or is liable to pay for the goods at a price calculated on the basis of the rate of exchange between New Zealand currency and sterling ruling immediately prior to the 18th day of August, 1948, the wholesale selling-price authorized by any Price Order or by any approval under section 16 of the Control of Prices Act, 1947, relating to any such goods shall be computed as if New Zealand currency had at all times been at parity with sterling, and every such Price Order and approval shall be read and construed accordingly.
