

## NOTICE UNDER THE PUBLIC WORKS ACT, 1928

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## PRIVATE BILL

In the matter of the Standing Orders of the General Assembly of New Zealand relative to Private Bills, and in the matter of a Private Bill intituled "An Act to Provide for the Constitution, and to Define the Functions and Powers, of a Disciplinary Committee to Exercise Disciplinary and Other Powers Over Registered Medical Practitioners."

NOTICE is hereby given that The New Zealand Branch of the British Medical Association intends to present a petition to the General Assembly of New Zealand for the passing of the said Bill.

The objects of the said Bill are to provide for the constitution of a Disciplinary Committee to exercise disciplinary powers over registered medical practitioners in certain cases of professional misconduct, and to inquire into and make recommendations to the Minister of Health upon complaints against registered medical practitioners in connection with matters arising under Part III of the Social Security Act, 1938, or the regulations made under that Act; and to define the functions and powers of such Disciplinary Committee.
