NOTICE is hereby given that the Palmerston North City Council intends to take, under the provisions of the Public Works Act, 1928, the following lands required for the purpose of a city depot and workshop:—

## BOROUGH OF NEWMARKET

## RESOLUTIONS MAKING SPECIAL RATES

IN pursuance of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and amendments thereto, the Newmarket Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

1. "That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £12,500, authorized to be raised by the Newmarket Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of purchasing and installing electro-matic traffic signalling apparatus within the Borough, the Newmarket Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of two decimal one pence (2-1d.) in the pound on the annual rateable value of all the rateable property in the Borough of Newmarket, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan, being for a period of fifteen (15) years or until the loan is fully paid off."

2. "That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £8,000, authorized to be raised by the Newmarket Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of erecting a men's convenience and ladies' rest-room and laying out of the grounds as a first stage of a community centre, the Newmarket Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one penny (1d.) in the pound on the annual rateable value of all the rateable property in the Borough of Newmarket, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable on the 1st day of August in each year during the currency of the loan, being for a period of twenty-five (25) years or until the loan is fully paid off."

3. "That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £12,000, authorized to be raised by the Newmarket Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of erecting a spectators' stand in permanent material on the western side of the Olympic Swimming Pool, and the installation of suitable equipment for heating the water in the pool, the Newmarket Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one decimal five pence (1-5d.) in the pound on the annual rateable value of all the rateable property in the Borough of Newmarket, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable on the 1st day of August in each year during the currency of the loan, being for a period of twenty-five (25) years or until the loan is fully paid off."

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

## Housing Loan, 1948, £10,000

IN pursuance of the powers and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and in pursuance and exercise of all other powers and authorities enabling it in that behalf the North Canterbury Catchment Board hereby resolves as follows:—
