*Warrant Declaring Buildings and Places to be Detention Barracks*

WHEREAS it is provided by Regulation 476 of the Regulations for the New Zealand Military Forces 1927, that "detention barrack" means any building or place in the possession of the Crown (not being a prison or police-gaol under the Prisons Act, 1908), declared by the Minister of Defence, by Warrant gazetted, to be a detention barrack for the purpose of the Army Act:

to be a detention barrack for the purpose of the Army Act.

*Exemption Order Under the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940*

PURSUANT to the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940, the Minister of Transport doth hereby order and declare that the provisions of clause (1) of Regulation 7 of the said regulations, so far as they relate to the driving of heavy trade motors, shall not apply to the persons hereinafter mentioned, but in lieu thereof the following provision shall apply:—

A motor-driver's licence issued under the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940 to any one of the persons described in Column 1 of the Schedule hereunder may authorize him to drive a heavy trade motor in the course of his employment on a farm or market garden of the respective employer described in column 2 of the said Schedule, but shall not authorize him, while he is under the age of eighteen years, to drive a heavy trade motor for any other purpose.

*Approval of Application by Petone Borough Council for Declaration of a Zone of Parking Restriction*

*Amending Speed Limitations Imposed Under the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act 1936, Section 3*

IN terms of section 3 of the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf the Minister of Transport doth hereby revoke that portion of the Warrant dated the 21st day of December, 1936,\* in so far as it applies to the roads described in the First Schedule hereto and doth hereby exclude those portions of roads described in the Second Schedule hereto from the limitation as to speed imposed by the said section.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

SITUATED within Glen Eden Town District—

Auckland-Helensville-Waiwera Main Highway No. 13 (all that portion within Glen Eden Town District, a distance of approximately 46 chains).

Waikumete - West Coast Main Highway No. 387 (all that portion from its junction with the Auckland-Helensville-Waiwera Main Highway at the north-eastern boundary of Glen Eden Town District to its junction with Scott Road, a distance of approximately 63 chains; and all that portion from its junction with Station Road to the western boundary of Glen Eden Town District, a distance of approximately 56 chains).

Auckland-Helensville State Highway No. 6 (all that portion within Glen Eden Town District, a distance of approximately 46 chains).
