

Declaring an Area to be a Closely Populated Locality for the Purposes of the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1936, Section 3

IN terms of section 3 of the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1936, the Minister of Transport doth hereby declare the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a closely populated locality for the purposes of the said section to the intent that a person driving any motor-vehicle on any road, street, or other place to which the public have access therein shall be subject to the maximum speed limit of thirty miles an hour fixed by the said section.

SCHEDULE

SITUATED in Eketahuna County—

All that area at Alfredton consisting of those portions of roads hereinafter described:—

- (i) Masterton-Weber, via Alfredton, main highway No. 816, commencing at point 2 chains measured along the said main highway in a northerly direction from its junction with the Eketahuna-Alfredton Main Highway No. 860, and terminating at a point 22 chains measured along the said main highway in a northerly direction from its junction with Castle Hill Road.
- (ii) Castle Hill Road, commencing at its junction with the Masterton-Weber, via Alfredton, Main Highway No. 816, and terminating at a point 14 chains measured along the said road in an easterly direction from the said junction.
