CONDITIONS

1. IMPLIED CONDITIONS

THE conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 and the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935 shall be incorporated herein and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

2. LICENCE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS

The licence hereby conferred is subject to compliance by the licensee with the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, and the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and with all regulations made or to be made in amplification or amendment thereof or in substitution therefor; provided that the licensee shall not, by virtue of this clause, be required, except in the normal course of alterations, repair, or maintenance, to reconstruct in conformity with the regulations hereinbefore mentioned any existing electric line or work which conformed to the regulations in force at the time of the construction thereof.

3. SYSTEM OF SUPPLY

The system of supply shall be a direct current system as described in paragraph (d) of clause 21-01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935.

4. CHARGES ON SALE

The charges for electrical energy shall not exceed the following amounts per calendar month :----

5. DURATION OF LICENCE

Unless sooner lawfully determined, this licence shall continue in force until the 31st day of March, 1970, or until electrical energy is available from an Electric-power Board or other public source of supply whichever is the earlier.
