## A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the twenty-ninth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, and published in the Gazette on the eighth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, at page 1285 (hereinafter referred to as the said Proclamation), an area of land containing 9,420 acres, more or less, situated in Blocks III, IV, and VIII, Abbey Rocks Survey District, and Block I, Mount Douglas Survey District, was set apart as a provisional State forest in terms of the War Legislation and Statute Law Amendment Act, 1918, and whereas an error was made in the Schedule to the said Proclamation and it is desirable that this error be rectified:

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section three of the Forests Amendment Act, 1925, do hereby amend the said Proclamation by omitting the words "7000 links along the eastern boundary of Block IV, Abbey Rocks Survey District," in the Schedule to the said Proclamation, and substituting the words "along the eastern boundary of Block IV, Abbey Rocks Survey District," in the Schedule to the said Proclamation shall take effect as from the date on which the said Proclamation was intended to take effect.
