RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Waterworks Improvement Loan, 1949

AT a meeting of the above Council held on the 19th September, 1949, the following resolution was passed:—

"In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Te Kuiti Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—
