RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Point Howard Water and Sewerage Supplementary Loan 1949, £450

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Hutt County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of £450, authorized to be raised by the Hutt County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of completing the work for which the Point Howard Water and Sewerage Loan 1938 was raised the Hutt County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of seven-eighths of a penny (¾d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (upon the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the Point Howard Special Rating Area as defined in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 55 of the 20th July, 1939, at pages 2028 and 2029, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years or until the loan is fully paid off."
