

ROTORUA COUNTY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING AND LEVYING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Counties Act, 1920, and every other power in that behalf enabling it, the Rotorua County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of six thousand one hundred and fifty pounds (£6,150), authorized to be raised by the Rotorua County Council under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of purchasing land and erecting thereon three dwellinghouses, the said Rotorua County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-thirty second of a penny ($\frac{1}{32}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the County of Rotorua, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty (30) years or until such loan is fully paid off.”

“That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest and other charges on a loan of thirteen thousand three hundred pounds (£13,300), authorized to be raised by the Oamaru Borough Council and called the Conversion Loan Repayment Loan 1950, of £13,300, the Oamaru Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one hundred and forty-six one-thousandths of a penny (0.146d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the whole of the Borough of Oamaru, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable half-yearly on the 1st day of January and the 1st day of July in each and every year until the last maturity date of the debentures securing the said loan, being the 1st day of January, 1955, or until all such debentures are fully paid off.”
