4. DURATION OF LICENCE

Unless sooner lawfully determined, this licence shall continue in force until the 31st day of March, 1970, or until electrical energy is available from an Electric-power Board or other general public source of supply, whichever is the earlier.

5. CHARGE ON SCALE

The charge for the sale of electrical energy shall not exceed 1s. 3¹/₂d. per unit for all purposes, or such other charge as may from time to time be approved by the Price Tribunal. Payment shall not be demanded from any consumer at intervals of less than twenty-one days apart.
