2. *Adult Apprentices*.—(i) For ex-overseas servicemen, or ex-home servicemen with long military service or who can establish loss of opportunity, or hardship owing to military service, the following scale will normally apply :—

(ii) There is no standard scale for civilian adult apprentices. Rates will be fixed by the Public Service Commission on the merits of each case.

(iii) Apprentices on attaining twenty-one years of age are paid adult allowance to bring total remuneration up to £300 per annum.

(iv) Married apprentices receive married man's allowance to bring total remuneration to £331 per annum.
