Crown Land Set Apart for an Automatic-telephone Exchange in Upper Harbour West Survey District

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Crown Land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart for an automatic-telephone exchange; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the thirty-first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of Crown land set apart: 8.7 perches. Being part Lot 18, D.P. 1, Township of Rothesay, being part Section 39.

Situated in Upper Harbour West Survey District (Borough of West Harbour), (Otago R.D.). (S.O. 9728.)
