Air to Air Firing Range

Position: Kai Iwi River Entrance, lat. 39° 53' S.; long. 174° 54' E., (approx.).

Details: The area bounded by the following lines has been defined as an Air to Air firing range. Commencing in Lat. 39° 57' 5 S., long. 174° 51' 0 E.; thence 169° for 6.75 miles; thence 261° for 12.5 miles; thence 303° for 15.75 miles; thence 045° for 6.75 miles; thence 105° for 20 miles to the point of commencement.

Remarks: The pilot of the target towing aircraft is the officer designated and briefed as the range safety officer, and he is responsible for ensuring that the range is clear of shipping before he orders firing to take place.
