A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section four of the Public Works Amendment Act, 1947, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the middle-line of a motor-way desired to be constructed in Blocks VI, X, and XI, Otahuhu Survey District—viz., a portion of the Auckland-Hamilton motor-way—shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall affect only that land situated within the limits coloured red on the plan marked P.W.D. 130083, referred to in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Amending the Constitution of a Rural Fire District

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 19th day of October, 1949

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Forests and Rural Fires Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Order in Council dated the seventeenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, and published in the *Gazette* on the eighteenth day of the same month at page 1398 (hereinafter referred to as the said Order in Council), is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) By omitting from the second column of the Second Schedule the number "1,970", and substituting the number "1,050";

(b) By omitting from the second column of the Second Schedule the number "1,050", and substituting the number "1,970".

2. The regulations made by the said Order in Council are hereby amended by repealing Regulation 2, and substituting the following regulation:—

"2. The Rural Fire Committee Regulations 1949, so far as they are applicable and with the necessary modifications, shall apply to the district, and these regulations shall be deemed to be special regulations for the purpose of those regulations."

3. The regulations made by the said Order in Council are hereby further amended by revoking subclause (2) of Regulation 3, subclauses (2), (3), and (4) of Regulation 4, and Regulations 5 to 19.
