RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Collingwood Reticulation Loan No. 2, £7,000

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Golden Bay Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of £7,000, authorized to be raised by the Golden Bay Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for reticulating that part of the Board's Area described in the *N.Z. Gazette* No. 43, dated 21st June, 1945, page 805, the said Golden Bay Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-half of a penny ( $\frac{1}{2}$ d.) in the pound upon the capital rateable value of all rateable property described in the above-mentioned *Gazette* notice, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off."

Collingwood Reticulation Loan No. 2, £23,000

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Golden Bay Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of £23,000, authorized to be raised by the Golden Bay Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for reticulating that part of the Board's area described in the *N.Z. Gazette* No. 43, dated June 21st 1945, page 805, the said Golden Bay Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one and five-eighths of a penny ( $1\frac{5}{8}$ d.) in the pound upon the capital rateable value of all rateable property described in the above-mentioned *Gazette* notice, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off."
