Additional Land Taken for a Secondary School in the Borough of One Tree Hill

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the additional land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for a secondary school; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the twenty-eighth day of November one thousand nine hundred and forty nine of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of additional land taken : 1 acre 3 roods 0.5 perches.
