(5) Except for the purpose of consuming feed running to waste and keeping the pasture in good order, no stock other than travelling stock, and one horse as may be required for the use of the caretaker appointed by the said Council, shall be permitted to graze within the boundaries of the said reserve.
(6) The said Council shall prepare a report each year ending on the thirty-first day of March, together with a statement of receipts and expenditure in connection with the said reserve.
A copy of every such report and statement shall be sent to the Minister of Lands as soon as possible after each financial year.
