Reticulation Loan 1949, £6,000

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Golden Bay Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £6,000, authorized to be raised by the Golden Bay Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for reticulation extensions and improvements, the said Golden Bay Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-eighth of a penny ($\frac{1}{8}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Golden Bay Electric-power Board District, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
