

Foreshore Licence: Ngauruawahia, Waikato River.—Wharf and Shed—Roose Shipping Company, Limited

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 9th day of February, 1949

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act, 1923, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby license and permit the Roose Shipping Company, Limited, of Mercer (hereinafter called the company, which term shall include its successors and assigns, unless the context requires a different construction), to use and occupy a part of the foreshore and land below the low-water mark at Ngauruawahia, on the Waikato River, as shown on approved plan marked M.D. 5277, and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, for the purpose of maintaining a wharf and shed thereon as shown on the said plan, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the company upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

CONDITIONS

1. THIS licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1940, and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply thereto.

2. The term of the licence shall be fourteen years from the 1st day of February, 1949.

3. The premium payable by the company shall be one pound (£1), and the annual sum so payable by the company shall be five pounds (£5).

4. The master of every vessel discharging ballast at the said wharf shall have all such ballast taken away and deposited above high-water mark or at such place as may be approved by the Minister, or by any person appointed by the Minister for that purpose.
