## ORDER IN COUNCIL At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 15th day of March, 1950

#### Present :

THE HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL WHEREAS, at the request of the Rotorua County Council, the Local Government Commission, in pursuance of the provisions of the Local Government Commission Act, 1946, has made inquiry into certain proposals for an alteration of the boundaries of the County of Rotorua and the County of Taupo:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to give effect to the final

And whereas it is deemed expedient to give effect to the final scheme and to make supplementary provisions for giving full effect to such scheme :

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in him by the Local Government Commission Act, 1946, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf. His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare that as on and from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and fifty, the area described in the First Schedule, hereto shall be excluded from the County of Taupo and included in the County of Rotorua; that the boundaries of the Counties of Rotorua and Taupo as so altered shall be those set forth under the respective headings in the Second Schedule hereto; that the area added as aforesaid to the County of Rotorua shall be included in the South Riding of that county; that the boundaries of the South Riding as o altered shall be those set forth in the Third Schedule hereto; and, with the like advice and consent, doth hereby also declare that the alteration of boundaries of the said counties hereinbefore made shall be deemed to have been effected under the Counties Act, 1920.
