Declaring Portions of Railway Land Near Springfield to be Crown Land

A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1948.

1	2	7	Railway Land in Proclamation 129, Canterbury Registry, formerly part Reserve 1798, situated in Block XI, Kowai Survey District; coloured sepia.
0	0	1.3	Railway Land in Proclamation 129, Canterbury Registry, formerly road, situated in Block XI, Kowai Survey District; coloured blue.
2	1	21	Railway Land in Proclamation 129, Canterbury Registry, formerly Tramway Reserve, situated in Blocks XI and XII, Kowai Survey District; coloured orange.
2	1	10	Railway Land in Proclamation 129, Canterbury Registry, formerly Tramway Reserve, situated in Block XII, Kowai Survey District; coloured orange.

All in Tawera County. (S.O. 8188.)
