

Price Order No. 1133. (Amendment No. 1 of Price Order No. 1062)
(Milk and Cream—Blenheim, Greymouth, and Lyttelton Milk
Price Districts)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act, 1947, the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce doth hereby make the following amending Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 1133, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 1062* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1950.

3. Clause 3 of the principal Order is hereby amended by adding to the definition of the "Lyttelton Milk Price District" the following words: "and those places known as Teddington, Charteris Bay, and Church Bay."

MODIFICATION OF PRINCIPAL ORDER

4. Notwithstanding anything in the principal Order the maximum price that may be charged or received for any milk sold in those places known as Diamond Harbour, Teddington, Charteris Bay, or Church Bay shall be the appropriate price set out in the Schedule to this Order.
