Station; thence northerly along the right line to its intersection with the western boundary of Huiarau No. 3 Block; thence southerly along the said western boundary of Huiarau No. 3 Block to the western-most corner of Huiarau No. 1 Block; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundaries of Huiarau No. 1 Block, Small Grazing Run 98 and Section 1, all of Block V, Tutamoi Survey District, and Section 1, Block VI, Tutamoi Survey District; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of the last-mentioned Section 1, Section 2, Block V, aforesaid and Sections 2 and 1, Block IX, Tutamoi Survey District, to the southern corner of the last-mentioned section; thence southerly, south-easterly, and south-westerly along the generally eastern boundaries of Waipaoa No. 2 Block to the northern corner of Waipaoa No. 3B Block; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of that block and its production to the middle of the Waingaromia River; thence south-westerly generally down the middle of that river to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Lot 11 on the plan numbered 1696 deposited as aforesaid; thence to and along that boundary and the north-eastern boundary of Lot 3 on the said plan numbered 1696 and its production to the middle of Waiapu Inland Road; thence north-easterly generally along the middle of that road to the middle of a public road; thence southerly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Lot 1 of Small Grazing Run 43A; thence south-easterly and south-westerly to and along that boundary and the south-eastern boundary of the said Lot 1 and its production to the middle of a public road; thence south-easterly and south-westerly generally along the middle of that road to a point in line with the northern boundary of Section 1, Block XV, Waingaromia Survey District; thence to and along that boundary and the north-eastern boundary of Section 2, Block XVI, Waingaromia Survey District, to the middle of the Mangarara Stream; thence easterly down the middle of that stream to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Waimata North No. 1A 2 Block; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary, the north-eastern boundary of Section 3, Block XVI, Waingaromia Survey District, and the generally north-eastern boundaries of Lot 2 on the plan numbered 2620 deposited as aforesaid; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of Section 2, Block XIII, Uawa Survey District, and its production to the middle of the Pakarae River; thence easterly and southerly generally down the middle of that river to a point in line with the northern boundary of Pakarae No. 1D Block; thence easterly and south-easterly to and along that boundary and the northern and north-eastern boundaries of Pakarae 1A Block to the sea-coast; thence southerly generally along the sea-coast to Paritu the point of commencement, and including all adjacent islands.

*Varying a Proclamation Proclaiming a Tribal District Under the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act, 1945*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section six of the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act, 1945, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby vary the Proclamation made on the fifth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, and published in the *Gazette* on the eleventh day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, at page 265, declaring certain parts of New Zealand to be a tribal district for the purposes of the said Act, by excluding from the Schedule thereto the description of the Waitemata Tribal District and substituting therefor the description appearing in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

WAITEMATA TRIBAL DISTRICT

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District, being the whole of the counties of Waitemata and Great Barrier Island, that portion of Eden County comprising the Auckland Hospital Reserve and the Auckland Domain, the City of Auckland, the Boroughs of Birkenhead, Devonport, Ellerslie, Helensville, Henderson, Mount Albert, Mount Eden, Mount Roskill, New Lynn, Newmarket, Northcote, Onehunga, One Tree Hill, Otahuhu, and Takapuna, the Town District of Glen Eden, the Road District of Mount Wellington, and Panmure Township, and including therein the islands of Motuihe, Motutapu, Pine, Rangitoto, Waiheke, and other small adjacent islands.

Also all that area, being portions of the Manukau County and Harbour, bounded by a line commencing at a point in Block VIII, Titirangi Survey District, on the line of mean high-water spring tide of the Manukau Harbour and in the middle of Waikowhai Road, and running easterly generally along the aforesaid line of mean high-water, to and along the south-eastern boundary of part of Allotment 7 of Section 17 of the Suburbs of

Auckland, along a right line across the Newmarket-Westfield Railway, to and along the southern boundary of part of Allotment 6A of Section 17 aforesaid, and along another right line to a point in the middle of the Great South Road and in line with the middle of Sylvia Park Avenue; thence southerly generally along the middle of the said Great South Road, to and along the eastern side of the North Island Main Trunk Railway to the middle of Massey Road; then south-westerly and westerly generally along the middle of Massey Road aforesaid, to and along the middle of Ascot Road to the line of mean high-water aforesaid; thence north-westerly generally along a right line across the said Manukau Harbour to the point of commencement.

*Altering the Boundaries of the Waitaki Electric-power District*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Electric-power Boards Act, 1925, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby alter the boundaries of the Waitaki Electric-power District so as to include the area described in the Schedule hereto, the said area being part of the existing Outer Area of the South Canterbury Electric-power District.

SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the Waimate County bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Waitaki River on the boundary of the Waimate County and proceeding thence north-easterly, south-easterly, easterly, south-easterly, easterly, south-easterly, and north-easterly along the Waimate County boundary to the Mount Nimrod Trig. Station; thence southerly down the middle of the north branch of the Waihao River to the northern boundary of Block VII, Waihao Survey District; thence westerly along the northern boundaries of Blocks VII and VI, Waihao Survey District, and southerly along the western boundaries of Blocks VI, X, and XIV, Waihao Survey District, and Blocks II and VI, Elephant Hill Survey District, to the Waitaki River; thence by a right line to the middle of the said river; thence north-westerly up the middle of the Waitaki River to a point opposite the southernmost corner of Section 28411, Block XIV, Hakataramea Survey District; thence to and across a road to the southernmost corner of Section 28411 aforesaid; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of Section 28411 aforesaid to the south-western boundary of Section 36122, Block XIV, Hakataramea Survey District; thence south-easterly along the last-mentioned boundary to the southernmost corner of Section 36122 aforesaid; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of Section 36122 aforesaid to the south-western boundary of Section 33824, Block XIV, Hakataramea Survey District; thence north-westerly, north-easterly, and south-easterly along the south-western, north-western, and north-eastern boundaries of Section 33824 aforesaid to the north-western boundary of Section 36121, Block XV, Hakataramea Survey District; thence north-easterly and south-easterly along the north-western and north-eastern boundaries of Section 36121 aforesaid to the southernmost corner of Section 36119, Block XI, Hakataramea Survey District; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of Section 36119 aforesaid to the southernmost corner of Section 32623, Block XI, Hakataramea Survey District; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of Section 32623 aforesaid and Section 28321, Block XI, Hakataramea Survey District to the Hakataramea River; thence across the said river to the southernmost corner of Section 31509, Block XI, Hakataramea Survey District; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundary of Section 31509 aforesaid to the Hakataramea Main Road and across the said road to the southernmost corner of Section 31772, Block VII, Hakataramea Survey District; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundary of Section 31772 aforesaid to the southern boundary of Section 26075, Block VII, Hakataramea Survey District; thence easterly, northerly, and westerly along the southern, eastern, and northern boundaries of Section 26075 aforesaid to the south-eastern corner of Section 31541, Block VII, Hakataramea Survey District; thence northerly and north-westerly along the eastern and north-eastern boundaries of Section 31541 aforesaid to the south-eastern boundary of Section 30125, Block II, Hakataramea Survey District; thence north-easterly, north-westerly, and south-westerly along the south-eastern, north-eastern, and north-western boundaries of Section 30125 aforesaid to the northern boundary of Section 26079, Block VI, Hakataramea Survey District; thence westerly and southerly along the northern and western boundaries of Section 26079 aforesaid to the northern boundary of Section 31771, Block VI, Hakataramea Survey District; thence westerly along the last-mentioned boundary to the south-western corner of Section 35325, Block II, Hakataramea Survey District; thence northerly along the western boundary of Section 35325 aforesaid
