Details: A light buoy painted black and showing a group flashing light every 15 seconds has been established 203° 4½ cables from the above position.

NEW ZEALAND.—NORTH ISLAND.—NAPIER

Alterations in Buoyage

Position: (1) Centre of end of No. 4 Wharf: Lat., 39° 28' 5 S.; long., 176° 55' 3 E. (approx.).

Details: (a) The unlighted black can buoy, 930 ft. 001' from above the position is now exhibiting a flashing red light every second—viz., flash 0.3 second, visibility 4 miles. This buoy marks the inner eastern edge of the dredged channel.

(b) The light on the black can buoy, 2,300 ft. 353" from above position, has been changed from flashing red every 3 seconds to flashing green every 3 seconds—viz., flash ½ second, visibility 4 miles. This buoy marks the outer eastern edge of the dredged channel and its position is liable to alteration during dredging operations.

NOTE.—On Chart No. 2513 this buoy is shown 1,350 ft. 350" from the above position.
