## BALCLUTHA BOROUGH COUNCIL

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

**I**N pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Balclutha Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, principal, and other charges on a loan of £1,550 to be known as 'Baths Improvement Loan, 1948,' authorized to be raised by the Balclutha Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, and the Physical Welfare and Recreation Act, 1937, for the purpose of improving the borough baths, the said Balclutha Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of four-fifteenths of a penny ( $\frac{4}{15}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Balclutha, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years or until the loan is fully paid off."

## STATUTORY REGULATIONS

**U**NDER the Regulations Act, 1936, statutory regulations of general legislative force are no longer published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, but are supplied under any one or more of the following arrangements:—

- (1) All regulations serially as issued (punched for filing), subscription £1 12s. 6d. per calendar year in advance.
- (2) Annual volume (including index) bound in buckram, £1 5s. (Volumes for years 1941 and 1942 are out of print.)
- (3) Serially as issued and annual bound volume, as in (1) and (2) above, on combined subscription basis, £2 7s. 6d. per calendar year in advance.
- (4) Separate regulations as issued.

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
