Rocks Reported

Details: Rocks have been discovered in the following positions:—

- 1.3 miles 146° 5' from Baring Head Light, least water 5 ft.
- 1.2 miles 228° from Cape Palliser Light, least water 6 ft.
- 1.65 miles 205° from Cape Palliser Light, least water 8 fms.
- 1.1 miles 160° from Karori Rock Light, least water 4 fms.

NOTE.—Obstruction reported 1931 by s.s. "Hobart" and charted 151° 2.8 miles from Baring Head Light was not found on examination but area must be swept when ship fitted next spring before declaring non-existence.
