A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, and section 47 of the Public Works Amendment Act, 1948, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto now held for housing purposes is hereby set apart, subject to the rights created by memorandum of transfer No. 54393 (Southland Land Registry), for a workers' hostel; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 19th day of June, 1950.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land set apart: 2 acres 0 roods 13 perches.
