A green light flashing every 3 seconds, flash 0.3 seconds, height 37 ft., visible 3 miles, is exhibited. This beacon when in transit with the front leading beacon indicates the 30 ft. contour on the eastern edge of the entrance channel.

3. The lighted buoy previously marking the mole end will not be replaced.
