Defining the Middle-line of a Road in Block III, Awakino East Survey District-viz., a Deviation of the Te Kuiti-New Plymouth Main Highway

#### A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the middle-line of a road in Block III, Awakino East Survey District—viz., a deviation of the Te Kuiti-New Plymouth Main Highway—shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

COMMENCING at a point on the Te Kuiti – New Plymouth Main Highway approximately 4 chains north-east of the westernmost corner of Karu-o-Te-Whenua B No. 2B, Section 5a, No. 2 Block, and proceeding thence in a south-westerly direction generally for approximately 23 chains and passing in, into, through, or over the following lands, &c.,—viz., Karu-o-Te-Whenua B No. 2B, Section 5a, No. 2 Block; Karu-o-Te-Whenua B No. 2B, Section 5a, No. 3 Block; Karu-o-Te-Whenua B No. 2B, Section 5a, No. 4 Block—and terminating at a point on the aforesaid main highway opposite the southernmost corner of Karu-o-Te-Whenua B No. 2B, Section 5a, No. 1 Block, Block III. Awakino East Survey District, including No. 1 Block, Block III, Awakino East Survey District, including all adjoining and intervening places, lands, reserves, roads, tracks, lakes, rivers, streams, and watercourses: all in the South Auckland Land District. As the same is delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 130600, deposited in the office of the Minister of Works at Wellington.

In Council wenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Bay of Islands County Council on the seventeenth day of April, one thousand pine hundred and forty seven yis. nine hundred and forty-seven, viz. :-

"That this Council, being the local authority having control of the roads and streets hereinafter mentioned, hereby resolves that the provisions of section 128 of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the southern side of portion of Gillies Street fronting subdivision of Section 2, Suburbs of Kawakawa, and Lot 1, D.R.O. W. 46, being part Te Wharau Block, both of Kawakawa Town,"

such portion of road being described in the Schedule hereto.
